PROGRAM OPTIONS

- 1) one hour concert that can feature jazz, classical, or a mix of both.**
- 2) one hour educational jazz history lesson** featuring the Park Hill Brass in concert illustrating various jazz styles.
- 3) half day workshop** with the school jazz ensemble to help students understand style and improvisation techniques.
- 4) half /full day workshop on jazz, brass techniques, ensemble playing or a mix of each.**
- 5) brass in residence series** of days or half days over the period of a school year or semester with workshops and breakout sessions for individual instruments.
- 6) jointly performed concert** at the end of the workshop period with school jazz or classical ensembles.
